Safe Home Alone Readiness Program **S.H.A.R.P.**

for children ages 10 and older

This four-hour program provides valuable safety information for children who stay home alone. The course consists of two 90-minute classes followed by a one-hour graduation. It is required that at least one parent attend the graduation. Through role playing, hands-on activities, and speakers from local police and fire departments children will learn basic fire, medical and personal safety tips. Students who attend all three classes will receive a Certificate of Completion.

Dates: January 25th, February 1st and February 8th

The last class is the graduation with required attendance of at least one parent

Time: 5:00-6:30pm

Location: Middle School Library
